Purplish purple. Fresh and fruity bouquet. Notes of eucalyptus and blackcurrant, touch of cinnamon. In the mouth the wine is crisp and balanced. I also find freshness. A touch of bitterness on the finish but I think there is enough substance for the fruit expression to take over.

The colour is garnet with black fruit aromas. The wine is supple and fluid, without the slightest asperity except for some tannins that need to melt.

Tasted in Hamburg. Raspberry and raspberry, mint taste on the nose, sage pastille, cherry heart, good freshness, little new wood. In the mouth, linear construction, short and low soft part, medium grained tannins, integrated taste alcohol, minerality and juiciness give not immense depth, but will become but will be pleasant in a few years It will be a good meal companion

Medium ruby colour. The nose is expressive, herbaceous, with a mix of dark berries and cherries that meet an interesting, fine cinnamon note. The attack is already wonderfully approachable, with medium body, a lively acid structure and well-integrated tannins. The finish is juicy and fresh, finishing on red fruits with a little blood orange. Pairing, simple, easy to drink. 2022-2032

**Jancis Robinson, February 2022**

Full bottle 1,265 g. 90% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc grown in a vineyard that's only just over 1 hectare in size. Transparent garnet with a very pale rim. Fresh, lively nose. Quite simple; very much a petit château with light gaminess. 13%
